Valdosta State University Student Union Facts

Construction began on the Student Union in August 2008 with the demolition of the old gym and former union building. Construction was completed Dec. 17, 2009, and the union's doors were opened Jan. 7, 2010. Construction costs for the project totaled \$35,021,714 and the overall bond package including funds for furniture, fixtures, and equipment, architect fees, and financing costs totaled \$43,190,000. The bonds were issued through the South Regional Joint Development Authority. The building's design was created by the partnership of Ellis-Ricket and WTW and the building was constructed by Skanska.
